- **All players (EXCEPT ECNL & NPL) residing in the state of Kentucky are REQUIRED by KY Youth Soccer to apply for an Out of State Release** allowing them to be carded to play for a club in another state. A new release is required each year. The form is submitted online and approval is received by email. **Please forward the release to : kcbesc@gmail.com**

NEW UNIFORM KITS FOR THE 2025-2026 SEASON!

- **SAME KIT** as 2024/25 Season
- Returning Players will keep their numbers.
- Player numbers will be **ASSIGNED** to new players.
- Uniform kits will need to be ordered online through **SOCCER.COM**.
- Sizing & reference guides will be available through the soccer.com ordering portal.

- An email will be sent to new U11-U14 players from SOCCER.COM within approximately 3 weeks following tryouts.
- An email will be sent to new U15-19 players late August - September.
- Uniform Ordering emails will be sent to the PRIMARY registration person's email address. (Please be sure your email address in our registration system is up to date)

Typically it takes 2-4 weeks to receive the uniform order....so don't wait! (Please be sure your email address in our registration system is up to date)

IMPORTANT CLUB & TEAM FEES INFORMATION:

By accepting a roster spot to the team for the 2025-2026 season you acknowledge a commitment to pay the club fees and team fees as outlined.

1. Unless a player moves away from the Evansville area where travel is a burden or sustains a season ending injury, the set club and team fees require payment.
2. Quitting a team for any reason does not allow for refund or non payment of your commitment to the program.

The Indy Eleven Spirit coaching staff, administration and directors are committed to providing a fun, safe, and healthy environment for our players. While providing an opportunity to learn the rules of the game, good sportsmanship and fair play is expected from all participants, players and parents. It is our desire to produce highly competitive teams while developing players by providing the best coaches, opportunities and facilities. IES encourages an atmosphere of respect, cooperation, support, and loyalty within our teams and the club. Member players and families are expected to reciprocate by honoring their commitment to an IES team for the season which they have accepted a position.

U11-U19 Competitive travel players are signing with IES for a one-year commitment. IES has the right to hold the player to this one-year commitment upon tryout acceptance and payment of the commitment fee. Indiana Soccer Association prohibits transfers during the season between clubs without the original club's permission. It is the intent of Indiana Fire Academy South to uphold this ruling. ***A carded IES player cannot train or play for an unaffiliated club or it's affiliates or train privately with a coach of an unaffiliated club or entity. IES players are not permitted to guest play for another unaffiliated club for tournament play. By accepting this roster spot, you are committing to a 1 year agreement with Indy Eleven Spirit.***

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

IES is committed to offering PARTIAL club fee assistance to families with financial concerns. Team Fees are the full responsibility of the player/family.

Indy Eleven Spirit Code of Conduct & Expectations:

****Players**

Understand the laws of the game and play by them.

Make every reasonable effort to attend all matches and training sessions.

If a player will be unavailable for training or a game, the player must inform the team coach in advance.

Be punctual for all training sessions and games.

Do not argue with the game officials.

Cooperate to ensure that the rules of the game are upheld.

Cooperate with IES coaches, teammates, opponents, and game officials.

Support your teammates and coaches.

Be gracious in defeat and dignified in victory.

Do not talk to fans for either team during games.
Play fairly and exercise good sportsmanship.
No fighting/physical violence
No foul or abusive language or physical violence
No consumption of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs
Support other IES teams
Be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat.

****Coaches**

Understand the laws of the game and require players to understand and follow them.
Coach the players in accordance with IES expectations and the overall good of the game.
Respect the rights and dignity of each individual.
No foul, abusive, or profane language.
Act as a positive role model for all players.
Be punctual for all training sessions and games.
Coaching from the sidelines during games should be limited and positive.
Do not argue with game officials.
Be honest with your players and parents.
Do not criticize a player in front of other players.
Support other coaches, teams, and players in the club.
Wear appropriate attire to all training sessions and games in accordance with the club's contract obligations.
Always conduct yourself for the good of the game and the good of the club.
Tobacco, alcohol, and non-prescription drugs are prohibited during all training sessions and games.

****Parents**

Parents will acknowledge that all players are in the care of IES staff during all training sessions and games.
Refrain negative comments from the touchline.
Do not criticize your child's teammates or coaches in the presence of your child or his/her teammates.
Use of foul or abusive language will be subject to review by IES Administration.
Fighting or physical violence will result in an automatic suspension of the involved parent from IES premises and activities.
Parents are to accept the match official's decision in all cases.
No arguing with game officials.
Be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat.

****Club**

The Club will not tolerate sexual, racial, or any other type of discrimination.
The Club will encourage an atmosphere of openness, cooperation, and support.
The Club will encourage loyalty within the team and the Club.
IES members will positively promote the image, and development of the game of soccer.

****Violations**

Coaches have primary responsibility for addressing violations by players.
The Directors of Coaching have primary responsibility for addressing violations by coaches.
Team managers and coaches have primary responsibility for addressing violations by parents, in consultation with the IES Directors
The Executive Board of Directors will address serious or repeated violations.

Sanctions that may be imposed include, but are not limited to, reprimand, suspension from team and club activities and facilities, and in certain cases, expulsion from the club. When appropriate, the Executive Board shall report violations to Indiana Soccer Association, US Club Soccer and US Youth Soccer Association. IES will support and impose all sanctions recommended or imposed by ISA, US Club Soccer or USYSA.

By choosing the acceptance you are acknowledging that you have read all the information above and will provide all documents required as listed before being allowed to participate in the 2025-2026 season.
